



Rochford Estate Rosé 2017

Varieties: 100% Pinot Noir

Winemaker tasting Notes:

Light blush colour. Delicate aromatics of red summer fruits and watermelon. A gastronomic wine, combining healthy acidity, richness and structure without too much colour and tannin. Long and fine with lingering liquorice and berry flavours.

Viticulture Notes:

Our Hill Road vineyard and winery is located at Coldstream, 40kms east of Melbourne in Victoria's oldest grape growing region, the Yarra Valley. Grown on ancient, mountain derived sandy clay loams, these rocky soils combined with our thirty plus year-old vines are at the heart of this wine.

2017 was a return to a classic Yarra Valley growing season after several warm years, however we were blessed with perfect sunshine for the majority of the harvest period.

Harvest: Hand-picked on the 15th of March

Vinification: Whole bunch pressed to 50% stainless steel, 50% 4yo tonneau. Natural fermentation on solids, barrels stirred when necessary.

Elevage: Assemblage six months after fermentation, filtered just prior to bottling.

Technical Data:

Alcohol 12.5%
