



Rochford Yarra Valley Estate 2015 Cerberus

Varieties: 48% Sauvignon Blanc, 24% Viognier, 13% Chardonnay, 7% Gewurztraminer, 7% Sylvaner, 1% Pinot Gris

Winemaker Tasting Notes:

Light straw. Exotic aromatics of tropical fruits, white flowers and grass. Energetic palate that has a solid core of fruit, natural acid balances the touch of residual sugar. Long and linear palate.

Viticulture Notes:

Our Hill Road vineyard and winery is located at Coldstream, 40kms east of Melbourne in Victoria's oldest grape growing region, the Yarra Valley. Grown on ancient, mountain derived sandy clay loams, these rocky soils combined with our thirty-year-old vines are at the heart of this wine.

2015 will be remembered as one of the finest harvests ever seen in the Yarra Valley. Above average yields, little disease pressure, excellent natural acidity and fruit flavours kept both winemakers and viticulturists happy.

Vinification Hand-picked, whole bunch pressed to a mix of aged French Puncheons. Natural fermentation, aged on lees, racked just prior to bottling.

Elevage Three months in 500litre Puncheons
