

Rochford. Captivate the senses.

Estate Blanc de Blanc 2018

Varieties: Chardonnay 100%

Tasting Notes:

Medium/pale yellow with flashes of green. Fresh, lemon zesty nose with warm doughy yeast undertones. A bright, vibrant evolution on the palate leading onto a round middle with freshly baked bread sweetness shot through with citrus pith and green apple flavours finishing with dry iced tea tannins.

Viticulture Notes:

Located within two kilometers of Rochford's Hill Road Winery at Coldstream - 40kms east of Melbourne, the grapes for this wine come from the property formerly known as Briarty Hill and re-named "Isabella's Vineyard" upon its purchase in December 2009. This vineyard is situated at the eastern end of the contour that is home to some of the districts most celebrated vineyards, all of which share Briarty Road addresses. Grown on ancient, mountain derived sandy clay loams, these rocky soils combined with our thirty five year-old vines are at the heart of this wine.

Winemaking Notes:

Harvest: Hand Picked on the 10th of February
Vinification & Elevage: 100% whole bunch press using Méthode Traditionnelle, raised on yeast lees for +17 months before disgorging.
