## Latitude Pinot Noir 2021

### Tasting Notes:

Ripe strawberries, raspberries and rosy florals. Behind the fruit lies a welcoming savoury twiggy note. The palate is round and generous in texture packed with all the wild berry fruits. The tannin is gentle and frames the wine nicely all the while keeping the wine pretty.

### Viticulture Notes:

Our winemaking philosophy is to produce the best fruit possible in the vineyard and allow the wines to express the individuality of the vineyard and each growing season. The grapes for this wine were handpicked with viticultural practices based around maintaining balance in the vineyards, sustainability and responsiveness to changing environmental conditions.

2021 was a welcome return to close to ideal growing conditions for higher quality fruit here in the Yarra Valley. A prolonged, classical season allowed for brilliant definition of flavour across our range.

Pinot Noir clone: MV6

Vinification & Elevage: Fermented as whole berries, with short cold soak before 14 days on skins. Pressed to French oak barriques for malolactic fermentation and matured in oak for 7 months.
