Sharegarden Shiraz



Woodvale's Sharegarden range of wines takes us back to a golden era in the Clare Valley, the sixties and seventies, whereby many aspiring young vignerons managed a Sharegarden in partnership with the Stanley wine company. This unique arrangement allowing many to enter the industry at a difficult time, including my father Mort Mitchell. These hard working growers then building on this opportunity to increase their private holdings . . .

Varietal: Shiraz 100%

Region: Clare Valley

Vineyards: A classic Clare valley blend across four unique sites; Netherby, Quarry Road, Lakota and Milburn.

Winemaking: All blocks were harvested and kept separate throughout the winemaking process, each parcel pumped over twice daily by hand until completely dry before gently basket pressing to older French oak hogsheads. Cellar matured for fifteen months before final blending and assemblage in August 2019.

Cellaring: At least ten years

Tasting Notes: The Sharegarden Shiraz is deep red in colour, with youthful crimson tints. The nose featuring dark cherries, subtle French oak spices and cocoa. The palate is rich and smooth, with layers of chocolate, licorice and savoury notes, beautifully supported by fine grained tannins and natural acidity.

Alcohol: 14.5 % v/v

Food Pairing Suggestion: Barbequed beef, steaks and aged cheeses.
