Devils Creek Sauvignon Blanc

Devils Creek brand comes from the name of the creek which runs through the Michelini Vineyard in High Country Victoria. The creek itself has a long history dating back to the 1800's, where the Buckland Valley was home to thousands of gold miners hoping to strike it rich. The Creek was a vital water supply to many of the gold miners in the area and it famous for disappearing underground for extended periods haunting the locals and only returning in plentiful rains. The locals likened this to the Devil himself and hence the name.

Wine Profile

Region: Alpine Valleys / King Valley

Colour: Medium straw

Aroma: Honey dew melon and kiwi fruit

Palate: Crisp acidity promotes flavours of green apple and melon with hints of lemon. Palate is rounded out with a hint of sweetness.

Production notes: Picked at first light in the cool of the morning. Moderate skin contact and then pressed off skins and underwent a moderate warm 10 day ferment in stainless tanks to promote richness

Food Pairings: Light seafood dishes such as grilled shrimp skewers with green tahini sauce.
