Michelini Italian Selection Nebbiolo

Nebbiolo ("Nebby-oh-low") is a full-bodied red wine more famously known from the Piedmont region in Italy.

Nebbiolo is one of the worlds great wine varieties. Combining power and grace, it is a wine that is at once alluring and satisfying.

Wine Profile

Region: Alpine Valleys

Colour: Deep garnet red

Aroma: Tar, roses and cool choc mint

Palate: Finely structured and medium bodied. Dried herbs, red currant and cherry with firm tannins.

Production notes: Destemmed and crushed to small open fermenters. Ferments were plunged by hand twice daily and pumped over for aeration mid-ferment to promote colour extraction and to soften tannins.

Ageing potential: 10-15 years.

Maturation: Stored for 12 months in small format oak. 20% new and 20% 1-2 year old barrels.

pH: 3.49 **TA:** 6.4g/L **Alc:** 13.5%
