The Wine

Dalwood Vineyard is the oldest vineyard in Australia, originally planted by Wyndham in 1828. Located on the banks of the Hunter River near Branxton. First planted by George Wyndham in 1828 this is the oldest continually operating vineyard in Australia.

Winemaker's Notes

Ripe and exotic peach and melon fruit flavours follow onto a creamy cashew nut pallet with integrated oak. The pallet is with intriguing 'wild' ferment complexity.
